



## **CODE OF CONDUCT FOR SOCCER PLAYERS OF CLUB GJOA – FALL SEASON 2011**

Both the Player and the Player's parents/guardians understand that the Club is committed to the Player's well being and soccer development.

In registering the Player with SC Gjøa, the Club, the parents/guardians and the Player agree to the following Code of Conduct.

### **THE SOCCER CLUB AGREES TO PROVIDE**

- A safe environment in which the Player can learn and develop without fear of abuse
- medical monitoring and support for the Player
- A structured soccer learning program, appropriate to the age, ability and development of the Player
- Participation in soccer matches arranged by the CJSL and other US soccer associations
- Trained, screened and qualified coaching staff
- Guidelines to the Player and parents/guardians on the best ways to contribute to the Player's soccer and personal development to ensure the continued academic and personal development of the Player
- Regular communication to the Player and parents/guardians on the Player's progress
- A Code of Conduct for SC Gjøa

### **THE PLAYER AGREES TO**

- Attend practices regularly and punctually and behave with self-discipline
- Practice the techniques and skills taught by the coaching staff and attempt to apply them in matches
- Participate in league matches and tournaments as requested by Manager/Coach
- Follow a lifestyle appropriate to development – spending leisure time positively and heeding trainer's advice regarding eating, drinking, relaxing and sleeping sensibly
- Adhere to the Club's Code of Conduct

### **THE PARENTS/GUARDIANS AGREE TO**

- Encourage and help the Player meet targets, including this Code of Conduct, homework tasks and soccer practice

- Support the Player without pressure, praise good work and refrain from criticising mistakes
- Refrain from directing any verbal, physical, emotional or psychological abuse towards players/staff of SC Gjøa/Sonesoccer, opposition teams and game/league/tournament officials
- Set a good example to the Player for on- and off-the-field behavior
- Communicate with club officials, team managers, and/or coaches, keeping them informed about any matters affecting the Player
- Assist the player's soccer development by being punctual to training and matches
- Where possible, give team manager and/or coaches at least 24 hours notice if the player is unable to attend a training session or game
- Adhere to the Club's Code of Conduct
